

Golf Guests

The Green Tree Country Club Golf Course Rules and regulations of Play are written and enforced in the spirit to enhance the enjoyment of golf, maintain the integrity of the game, protect the course and equipment, regulate the speed of play, insure the safety for players and honor the rights of the membership. Each player is required to abide by these rules at all times. The Board has charged the Golf Professional Staff with the responsibility for monitoring play and reporting violations.

Violations of these Green Tree Country Club Golf Course Rules and Regulations of Play may result in action by the Board in the form of fines, suspension and/or revocation of Club Privileges.

Members must accompany their guests at all times. This rule does not apply to House Guests. Only the Director of Golf may grant exceptions to this rule. Members are responsible for their guests' behavior and action at all times.

ALL MEMBERS must register their guests by having them sign the guest book. Guest fees must be paid in the Golf Shop before beginning play.

All guests are restricted to only playing 8 times per calendar year.

Golf guest fees for Weekdays, Weekends and Holidays will be established by the Board. Members will be restricted to a maximum of four (4) golfing guests on Saturday, Sunday and Holidays. Additional guests must be approved by the golf Professional Staff in advance.

House Guest passes are available for a visiting family member or guest who is staying at the member's house during their visit. House Guests are permitted to utilize the Club's facilities with the use privileges of a Club member for one (1) calendar week. Each House Guest is limited to two (2) weeks of use per year and must live a minimum of 100 miles from the Club.

GENERAL RULES

- **A. ALL GOLFERS** must register and pay any fees in the golf shop before beginning play. All play will begin on the starting tee designated by the Professional Staff.
- B. Proper attire must be worn at all times on the golf course and practice areas. Shirts with collars and/or appropriate golf shirts are required for all golfers. Sweat suits, tank tops, swim suites, cut-off shorts and gym shorts are not appropriate golf attire. Junior players will be required to follow the same guidelines. Metal spike golf shoes are not permitted on the golf course, practice area or clubhouse. Tennis shoes or flat soled shoes may be worn with the approval of the Golf Professional Staff.
- C. Every player must have a set of clubs and golf bag. Two or more golfers playing out of one bag is not permitted.
- **D.** Golf play shall be governed by the U.S.G.A. rules as amended only by the local rules which are listed on the scorecard and by temporary changes necessitated due to conditions of the course.

- **E.** Pull carts and golf bags shall not be allowed in the Club Building. There will be no pull carts stored in the club Storage Area. Pull carts are not permitted on tees and greens.
- F. Fishing for golf balls in any of the lakes is prohibited, except for the retrieval of your own golf ball.
- **G.** Small children, other than junior golfers, that accompany adults playing golf are not permitted on greens, tees, or sand traps at any time.
- H. All juniors below the age of 12 must be supervised unless permission is given otherwise by the Golf shop staff.
- I. Access to the golf course is limited to Members and their guests playing golf during course operating hours only. No Pedestrian, bicycles, skateboards, scooters or unregistered private golf carts allowed at any time.
- **J.** All private property is out of bounds. Do not hit golf balls from private property and do not retrieve golf balls from private property without permission of homeowner.
- K. Immediately notify homeowner and Golf Shop Staff if you accidentally damage the property of a homeowner.
- L. Green Tree Country Club requires that in the event of lightning and inclement weather when the horn is blown, the golf course is immediately closed. The golf course will reopen when the horn is blown with three consecutive blasts. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- M. The use of Green Tree Country Club practice balls is prohibited outside the practice range facilities.

Green Tree Country Club is a *NON-SMOKING* facility. Smoking is *NOT PERMITTED* in the Clubhouse or on the Patio.
