



GUEST POLICIES

Swim Guests

All Green Tree Country Club members will always remember the pool is a FAMILY POOL and is for use by ALL members. All conduct in and around the pool should be appropriate for all ages. It is the member's responsibility to adhere to all of the rules listed below. In addition, each member will be responsible for the appearance and the conduct of their guests as well as ensuring that their guests comply with all rules. The Pool Management team will enforce all rules and have final say on compliance with the rules at the time of enforcement.

GENERAL

- A. Conduct at the pool must be such as to maintain the standards of the Club. The Green Tree Staff will enforce all swimming rules. The cooperation of all users is greatly appreciated.
- B. Members and their guests must register in the Tennis shop before entering the pool area.
- C. The Club is not responsible for any accidents resulting from use of the pool or loss or theft of bathing suits, articles of clothing or any other personal possessions.
- D. Green Tree Country Club may limit the number of guests a member may bring to the pool. A member of the club must accompany guests and pay the appropriate guest fee.
- E. Children under 12 years old are permitted in the pool area when accompanied and supervised by a responsible individual 16 years of age or older, or if such child is participating in swimming instruction.
- F. Children wearing swim diapers must be supervised at all times by an adult while in the pool.
- G. **Attire:** All swimmers must wear proper swimming attire.
 - 1) Men and boys are expected to wear hemmed shorts, cut offs are not permitted; garments are required to be of a length sufficient to cover the majority of the thigh and must be worn on hips not as "low riders".
 - 2) It is expressly forbidden for clothing to display offensive or inflammatory language or symbols.
 - 3) Ladies and girls are expected to wear suits that are not visibly offensive at the discretion of Pool Management. Two-pieces are allowed as long as they cover accordingly.
 - 4) It is expressly forbidden for clothing to display offensive or inflammatory language or symbols.
- H. Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated and may result in suspension of pool privileges.
- I. For safety reasons running on the pool deck, pushing others, dunking, or any dangerous games are not permitted.
- J. The throwing of hard balls, Frisbees, or any wet clothes is not permitted.
