



GUEST POLICIES

Tennis Guests

Green Tree Country Club offers a Tennis Facility with 5 floodlit tennis courts, as well as, a covered tennis pavilion. Our Tennis Professionals are committed to creating a friendly and courteous tennis atmosphere, where both adults and juniors can enjoy their leisure time on the courts.

Attire:

Proper attire must be worn at all times.

All players shall be adequately dressed in tasteful tennis attire. T-shirts must have sleeves and be full length.

Standard tennis shorts, skirts, or warm-up pants may be worn. No cutoffs, jogging shorts, swim suits or Bermuda length shorts are permitted.

Only regulation shoes designed for tennis may be worn. Jogging, basketball, and other non-tennis shoes are not permitted.

The Tennis Professionals will have the authority to approve or deny appropriate dress.

Guests:

Members must accompany their guests at all times. This rule does not apply to House Guests. Only the Director of Tennis may grant exceptions to this rule. Members are responsible for their guests' behavior and action at all times.

ALL MEMBERS must register their guests by having them sign in at the Tennis Shop.

Guest fees must be paid in the Tennis Shop before beginning play.

House Guest passes are available for a visiting family member or guest who is staying at the member's house during their visit. House Guests are permitted to utilize the Club's facilities with the use privileges of a Club member for one (1) calendar week. Each House Guest is limited to two (2) weeks of use per year and must live a minimum of 100 miles from the Club.
